HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

Before you start your application, make sure you have the following ready:

Compulsory documents you need before you can apply:

Make copies and certify the following documents:



- Your own Identity Document/ Unabridged Birth Certificate.
- Identity Document of each of your parents or legal guardians, as well as each household member living in your house.
- Recent payslip, letter of employment, not older than three months, for each parent, or the person who supports you, or your guardian or yourself if you are employed. This includes any income received from SASSA grants, Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF), or any retirement, life, disability or other benefits paid as a lump sum or in monthly payments.
- Death certificate if either of your parents is deceased.
- If you are supported by someone who is not your parent or legal guardian, please provide an affidavit explaining the reasons.
- If you have a disability, you will need a Doctor's certificate and please download the Disability Annexure A and fill it in here: <http://ow.ly/tJJe30ejff3>
- Please download the consent form here: <http://ow.ly/POCv30ea7qn> and fill it in with your parent/guardian's signatures. Applications without a consent form that is signed by all people whose incomes have been declared in the application will not be accepted, and will be considered as incomplete.

Scan the documents and store it on a USB flash drive.

You will need to attach all these documents to your application.
