3 Documents you need

Make copies and certify the following documents:

- Your own identity Document.
- Identity Document of each household member including parents or legal guardian living in your house.
- Latest Grade 12 results.
- A letter from the school informing NSFAS that you have been exempted from school fees.
- Recent payslip, letter of employment, not older than three months, for each parent, or the person who supports you, or your guardian or yourself if you are employed. This includes

any income received from SASSA grants, Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF), or any retirement, life, disability or other benefits paid as a lump sum or in monthly payments.

- Official pension slip or bank statement showing pension payment if your parents or the person who supports you or your legal guardian are retired.
- Death certificate if either of your parents is deceased.
- Divorce decree if your parents are divorced.
- If you are supported by someone who is not your parent or legal guardian, please provide an affidavit explaining the reasons.
- A SASSA letter if any of your family members are receiving a social grant
- If disabled - Doctor's certificate
