

NWU REGISTRATION 2019 OUTSTANDING DEBT

The Council of the NWU has approved the Financial Rules with regards to outstanding debt in November 2018. According to these rules no student will be allowed to register with outstanding debt of previous years and no student will be allowed to register without paying the minimum payable amount before or on registration.

Assistance during registration: NSFAS students

- 1 Approved NSFAS students will be allowed to register without paying the first minimum payment.
- 2 Approved NSFAS students with outstanding debt of 2018 will be allowed to register on signing of a DHET Acknowledgement of Debt (AOD) document.
- 3 Approved NSFAS students without debt will be automatically cleared to register online.

Assistance during registration: Other bursaries, loans & Fundi recipients

- 1 Submit written proof of the bursar, loan institution or Fundi.
- 2 If above students have outstanding debt, a written undertaking by the bursar, loan institution OR Fundi must be submitted to the effect that the outstanding debt will be covered.

Only students with payment arrangements will be individually assessed during registration



What to do?

Complete a student request form available at the Student Accounts and Bursary Counters to submit your payment arrangement plan.



What not to do?

- ✗ An affidavit will not serve as a payment arrangement if your household income is less than R350 000 per annum.
- ✗ Only first-year students in this category should report to the Student Accounts and Bursary Counters.
- ✗ NSFAS applications for senior students have already closed on 30 November 2018.

Failure to comply with the conditions of payment may result in:

- Deactivation of the student's university card,
- Refusal of admission to tuition,
- Refusal of admission to examinations,
- Non-issue of academic record and certificate of conduct,
- Non-issue of examination results,
- Non-issue of diploma or degree certificate - to be held in safekeeping at the NWU,
- Refusal of participation in the graduation ceremony,
- Refusal of registration as a student,
- Exclusion from university residence and
- Handing over to the debt collectors
