Prof Mello's research interests are in the area of monitoring and evaluation of performance. He has published over 20 articles as well as chapters in books and presented papers at both international and local conferences.

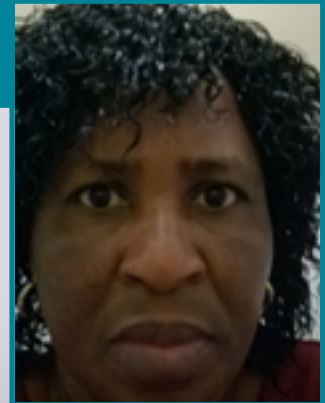
Prof Mello is the editor of the book titled "Managing Human Capital in the Public Sector. The book is prescribed by at least three Universities in South Africa.
