

INTEGRATED RISK ASSESSMENT OF OCCUPATIONAL POSITIONS AT NWU

Ref nr: NWU/OHS/OP/RA/001

Date of assessment: 27 June 2022 (Revision 09). (24 November 2021 (Original)).

Type of assessment: Integrated Issue-based risk assessment An issue-based risk assessment is designed to distinctly and clearly delineate and quantify risks associated with a particular hazard, in this case a biological hazard, the SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus), causing COVID-19. This risk assessment is applicable to determine the activities of staff members and the risk reduction strategies.

Purpose of NWU integrated Issue based risk assessment:

- To arrive at a clear understanding of the various occupational levels at the NWU that might be at risk of contracting or transmitting the coronavirus.
- To determine and establish risk controls to as far as reasonably practicable to manage the risk of exposure and health effects of COVID-19 in the workplace.
- To form the basis of a documented action plan to set minimum requirements for NWU staff to implement and comply with to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 at the NWU.
- To form the basis to conduct COVID-19 task specific risk assessment, exposure monitoring, screening and medical surveillance at the NWU.

Note: COVID-19 is an ongoing pandemic, and new information, research and legislation may affect the risk assessment. The risk assessment will be updated and reviewed as required.

Integrated Issue-based risk assessment

Table: Lists examples of COVID-19 control measures which must be used to reduce to risk of COVID-19 in each entity. Note that not all of these control measures may be applicable to every entity.

Eliminate	 Work-from-home where possible, but required for vulnerable employees – As recommended by NWU OHP Daily self-screening for signs and symptoms before leaving home, if ill/sick stay at home Self-isolate when experiencing Covid-19 signs/symptoms, inform your Director/Head and NWU Health Centre (online reporting) Testing of employees with signs/symptoms of Covid-19 Rearrange tasks/activities so that they are performed by the minimum required person (s), or by maintaining physical distancing measures (1 metres) Where possible, arrange facilities to maintain physical distancing
Reduce	 Make use of online meeting platforms where possible Minimise the time employees are in close proximity to others, with consideration of reconfiguration of tasks, shift rotation, physical
	barriers, environmental cleaning procedures and frequent hand washing

	to-face contact is essential, this should be kept to <15 minutes (where reasonably practicable);
	Install hand sanitations stations
	Make cleaning materials available in the workplace
	• Review the performance and servicing of ventilation and air conditioning systems and use fresh air in preference of recirculated air.
	Increase ventilation in enclosed spaces.
	Rooms should be well ventilated / windows opened to allow fresh air circulation
	Employees should wash their hands before and after using shared equipment / Clean equipment before and after use.
	Screen employees through daily DIY COVID-19 questionnaire (Online application) before entering the workplace

Outcome of NWU COVID-19 Integrated Risk Assessment

The NWU integrated risk assessment indicates that the pure risk of COVID-19 unduly exposes the NWU and its staff. The risks of COVID-19 are reduced and mitigated by numerous controls including vaccination. One of the key controls to reduce the risk of COVID-19 is to be fully vaccinated. This includes all the necessary booster shots. The outcome of the NWU integrated risk assessment for staff requires the following:

- All controls as listed to be adhered to and complied with by all staff, visitors and service providers.
- Staff are strongly encouraged to vaccinate to reduce the consequence of severe illness and reducing exposure risk to the NWU community.
- <u>The following occupational categories</u> at the NWU require full vaccination:
 - NWU Health Care Staff (Occ. doctor, nurses support staff and service provider staff assigned to the NWU Campus Health Care Centres (CHCC)).
- <u>The following occupational categories</u> at the NWU require full vaccination or assessment by the NWU Occupational Health Practitioner (OHP) to assess COVID-19 health risk posed to the employee. The Occupational health practitioner (OHP) where necessary will recommend any additional controls and/or medical surveillance requirements to mitigate the risk to protect the employee as far as reasonably practicable:
 - All occupational categories: Employees with comorbidities and over 60 years of age: Individual health assessment by NWU Health Dept to assess COVID-19 risk posed to employee (OHP to recommend additional controls required) after assessment.
- Employees with contra-indications to the COVID-19:
 - Must submit medical certificate to NWU Heath Care Centre (OHP).
 - Undergo health assessment by NWU Health Dept and possible medical evaluation.
- The following is required from service providers:
 - Service provider employees with comorbidities and over 60 years of age: Individual health assessment by Occupational health practitioner to assess COVID-19 risk posed to employee (OHP to recommend additional controls required) after assessment.

The NWU will closely monitor internal and external COVID-19 trends, changes nationally and internationally related to COVID-19; and where any changes or trends can possibly affect the NWU community's health, review the NWU COVID-19 risk assessments.
