The Ikatelelang Project transforms communities by:

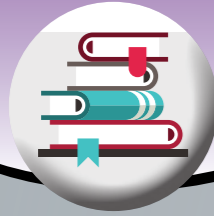
- Providing career guidance to help students with their futures.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



### Subjects:

Mathematics, Physical Sciences, Accounting, Economics, Business Studies, Life Sciences, and English.



### Program Duration:

The project runs for 17 Saturdays from February to September.



### Success Rate:

Since 2013, the matric pass rate for Ikateleeng learners has never fallen below 89%, achieving 97% in 2023 compared to the national average of 76.4%.



### Teacher Selection:


Teachers are carefully chosen based on stringent criteria, ensuring they contribute to the continued success of the project.
