- Certified copy of your South African ID or country's passport
- Copy of your academic records (if applicable)
- Copy of your previous qualifications (if applicable)
- A medical examination in accordance with the requirements of your country.
- An exception certificate issued by (USAF Universities South Africa: <https://mb.usaf.ac.za>) after you've received your final results.
