Use **Cambridge** and other systems to calculate the necessary admission points: <https://bit.ly/3OD2G3R>



Depending on which level you complete on the **Cambridge system**, you'll receive different scores.

- O-level/IGCSE levels get the lowest scores starting at 5.
- AS levels which is equivalent to the South African matric where an above 90% grade gets 8 and 80% and above gets 7, etc.
- A-levels which is equivalent to the first year at university get the highest with a grade A scoring APS = 10.

Apply to NWU in 5 EASY STEPS

1. CREATING YOUR UNIVERSITY NUMBER

(Start with step 2 if you already have a university number)

- Visit the online application platform: <http://bitly.ws/nW2q>
- Click on "New application"
- Click on "Create new university number" and complete all the fields.



Please remember, when you receive your university number, it does not mean that you have completed the application process. Complete all the steps below to ensure that your application is complete and submitted. Incomplete applications will not be processed by the university.

2. LOG IN

Your university number and login PIN will be sent to you via email and SMS. Use the university number and the PIN to log in. (Save your university number and PIN for future use and reference.)

- Currently in Grade 12
- Completed Grade 12

Please keep your email and cell phone number the same, since you will receive all important communications through these channels.

3. WHAT DO YOU WANT TO STUDY?



Complete all the fields. Use the yearbooks (<https://bit.ly/3WHvRpK>) to obtain more information about the qualifications, modes of delivery and curricula.

4. UPLOAD SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

To complete your application, as a prospective international student also need the following documents:

- A certified copy of your ID and passport
- A copy of your most recent results
- A copy of your academic records (if applicable)
- A copy of your most recent results and previous qualifications
- A visa that permits residency in Republic of South Africa (only applicable during the application process)
- Download and complete the NWU Undertaking form: <http://bitly.ws/nWYc>
- Medical examination according to your native country, South Africa, and NWU's requirements.



When you apply with a foreign qualification, you must apply for evaluation certificate from the Higher Education South Africa (HESA) or South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA).

Please make sure you upload all these documents. Your acceptance to the NWU can be delayed if you do not upload them.



5. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Please press the "Submit Application" button when you have completed your application to ensure we receive it.
